## MAIN EVENT

A PLEASURE RIDE ON SUNDAY 24<sup>th</sup> APRIL 2011

**FERRENSBY- Round trip via Flaxby & Coneythorpe**

**VENUE:** The field next to the General Tarlton pub, Ferrensby. By kind permission of Mr Bradley.

**From Knaresborough:** Leave the town on the A6055 Boroughbridge Rd. Ferrensby is the first village reached in approx. 2 miles. Continue into the village past the duck pond & the pub is on the left. The venue field is on the far side of the pub.

**From Boroughbridge/A1:** Leave Boroughbridge southwards & turn right onto the A6055 towards Minskip. Stay on this road for about 4 miles. Pass the village boundary sign for Ferrensby on the verge, the road turns sharp left. Indicate to the right at this point as you will see the entrance to the field on your right.

**Start:** Strictly between 10.00 & 11.00am. The long route is approx 12 miles & short route 8 miles. The routes are 80% bridleways and tracks and 20% quiet country roads. Maps will be supplied on the day. However, if you require a map beforehand please send a SAE with your entry form.

**PLEASE DO NOT SKIP OUT TRAILERS & WAGONS INTO THE FIELD & PICK UP ALL DROPPINGS.**

## HARROGATE BRIDLEWAYS PLEASURE RIDE RULES

### Horses and ponies:

- minimum age 4 years
- must be in a fit condition to carry out the work expected of them
- must be well shod i.e. No loose or missing shoes
- red or green tail ribbons must be worn, red - kicker, green - novice
- all tack must be in a safe, serviceable condition

### Riders:

- must wear hard hats to PAS 015 or BSEN 1384 at all times when mounted
- correct footwear for riding should be worn
- follow the marked route
- visibly wear club number bibs at all times during the ride
- all riders must commence between 10.00 and 11.00 am
- where there is a choice of route, riders must state which they intend to follow
- sign the disclaimer when entering the ride

- children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult (18 years +)
- if any change of rider is made after entry the Ride Organiser must be informed and any extra entry fee paid
- when approaching other riders from behind please slow to a walk and warn them of the intention to pass
- follow the Country Code - No litter, close all gates, show consideration to pedestrians and other road users
- stay on bridle paths and do not stray onto farmers land or go across privately maintained grass/lawns or verges
- The Ride Organisers decision is final
- Stewards are there for your safety and their instructions must be adhered to at all times.
- It is the riders responsibility to ensure the steward receives your number.
