## MAIN EVENT

A PLEASURE RIDE ON SUNDAY 25<sup>th</sup> July 2010

**FOUNTAINS ABBEY VISITOR CENTRE – Round trip via Galphy, Kirkby Malzeard & Winksley**

**VENUE:** Fountains Abbey Visitor Centre by kind permission of the National Trust.

**From Ripon:** From the town centre take the B6265 towards Pateley Bridge. Go past Studley Royal, after approx 3 miles from Ripon turn left signposted Visitor Centre. Turn into the centre's drive, the field is on the right about 400yds from the gate.

**From Harrogate:** Take the A61 to Ripon and follow the above directions.

**Start:** Strictly between 10.00 & 11.00am. The long route is approx 14 ½ miles. The routes are 50% bridleways and tracks and 50% quiet country roads. Maps will be supplied on the day. However, if you require a map beforehand please send a SAE with your entry form.

**PLEASE DO NOT SKIP OUT TRAILERS & WAGONS INTO THE FIELD & PICK UP ALL DROPPINGS.**

## HARROGATE BRIDLEWAYS PLEASURE RIDE RULES

<p><b>Horses and ponies:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- minimum age 4 years</li><li>- must be in a fit condition to carry out the work expected of them</li><li>- must be well shod i.e. No loose or missing shoes</li><li>- red or green tail ribbons must be worn, red - kicker, green - novice<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- all tack must be in a safe, serviceable condition</li></ul></li></ul>	<p><b>Riders:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- must wear hard hats to PAS 015 or BSEN 1384 at all times when mounted</li><li>- correct footwear for riding should be worn</li><li>- follow the marked route</li><li>- visibly wear club number bibs at all times during the ride</li><li>- all riders must commence between 10.00 and 11.00 am</li><li>- where there is a choice of route, riders must state which they intend to follow</li><li>- sign the disclaimer when entering the ride</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult (18 years +)</li><li>- if any change of rider is made after entry the Ride Organiser must be informed and any extra entry fee paid</li><li>- when approaching other riders from behind please slow to a walk and warn them of the intention to pass</li><li>- follow the Country Code - No litter, close all gates, show consideration to pedestrians and other road users</li><li>- stay on bridle paths and do not stray onto farmers land or go across privately maintained grass/lawns or verges</li><li>- The Ride Organisers decision is final</li><li>- Stewards are there for your safety and their instructions must be adhered to at all times.</li><li>- It is the riders responsibility to ensure the steward receives your number.</li></ul>
